

Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.2 – Release Notes,

Dial-In Phone Numbers (Premium Service),

Web Application for Text Resource Translations

February 14th 2008 – FDM

1 Summary

This is a combined announcement. It covers three different Collanos products and services, all being released at the same time.

Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.2 is a maintenance release of our flagship application. It contains primarily bug fixes and various enhancements, but also a small number of new features. The focus of this release was to fix defects discovered since releasing the last major version and to further improve the system for best user experience.

Dial-In Phone Numbers is a new premium service. Users can now subscribe to real phone numbers, making their Collanos Phone reachable from the outside, from any regular phone. Initially this service is being launched for Swiss numbers and available to Swiss residents only. Additional countries will be added gradually in the coming months.

Web Application for Text Resource Translations is a comfortable web application for all Collanos Translators, which are Ambassadors who signed up to translate Collanos Workplace into their languages. A simple to use Web application makes it very easy to translate text resources into any language of the planet.

- Fixes and improvements in Installer and Uninstaller
- New and improved “Date picker” GUI element
- Corrections to text translations (mainly for German)

Supported Platforms

As always, Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.2 is available in three main versions, for Microsoft Windows, Mac OS X, and Linux. For more details see our download page on the web and release notes of Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.1.

Compatibility

This release is fully compatible with the previous version 1.4.0.1. For details about compatibility with older versions, see the release notes published for Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.1.

Updating

This release is available both as complete installer package (www.collanos.com/downloads) and via automatic update service. Existing users will be prompted to automatically download updated components. The update process is triggered when Collanos Workplace is started.

When you run the installer package, it will detect that you have already Workplace installed on your computer and will suggest to update the existing installation. Make sure to update your existing Workplace installation.

You don't need to download and install Collanos Phone separately, because from now on Collanos Phone will always be contained in the integrated Collanos Workplace installation package.

It is always a good idea to make a backup of your data, before upgrading any software. In the preferences page you will find the section “Collanos Workplace / Workplace Data”. Select the “Backup” action and fill in a destination directory for your backup. Make sure there is enough free disk space on the destination hard drive.

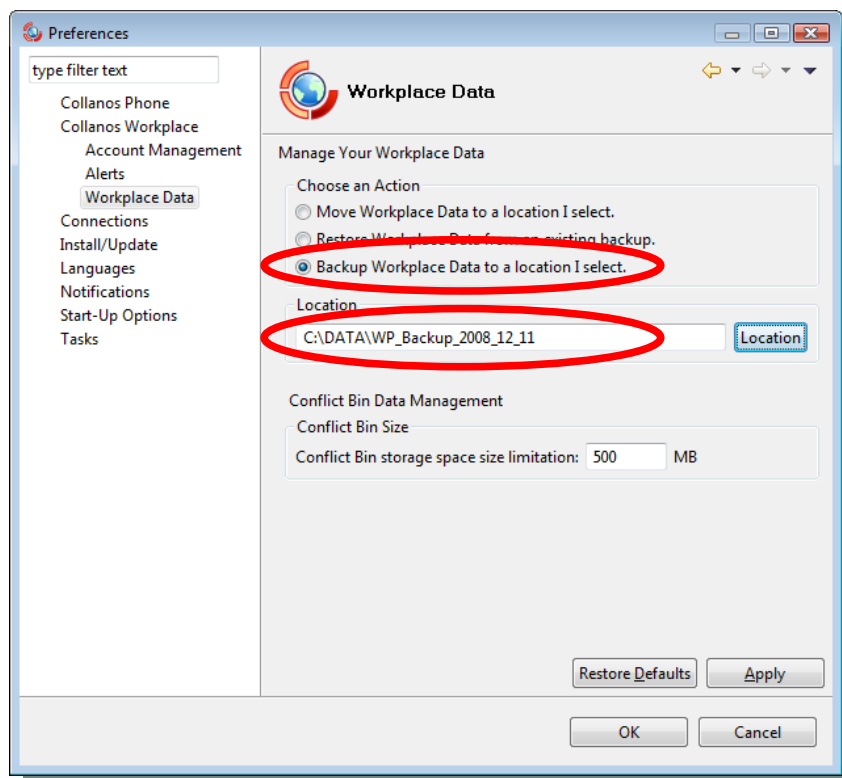


Illustration 1: Performing a backup of your data

Detailed Descriptions

This section describes the most important features and improvements in greater details.

Improved Presence

The presence system – i.e. showing who is online (green) & offline (grey) – has been improved in a number of ways. Overall it works and reacts faster, which means that status changes from you to others and from others to you will be reflected more rapidly.

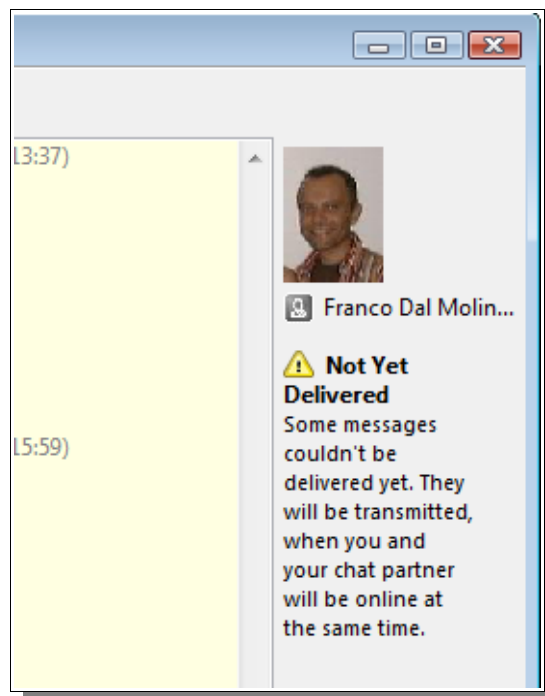
In the past it took several minutes for the contact list to show the presence initially, just after starting up Workplace. This happens now much faster. In the past it was also possible to end up with presence inconsistency between different windows, e.g. User A would be shown as offline in Contacts List, but as online in Chat window. The new system now works consistently across all parts of Workplace.

Please note that small delays of a few seconds (in some rare cases up to 10-20 seconds) are normal and can not be avoided completely. This has to do with the reality of the Internet as well as how Collanos users are connected with each other directly (so called “peer-to-peer” network).

The much improved presence system is the single most important element of this update!

Delivery Status Messages in Chats

We introduced a new way of notifying users when some of his Chat messages aren't transmitted yet. In the past we used red warning messages, written directly into the chat message flow, but they could not easily be removed dynamically when needed. The new system will indicate when one or several of your messages aren't delivered yet in a consistent way.

Technical Information Page

The technical information page is a hidden “under the hood” view of technical system details about Collanos' peer-to-peer network and central services. This feature isn't for average “everyday users”, but simply a diagnosis instrument to assist Collanos' technical support staff and other tech-savvy advanced users inspecting system details and analyzing connectivity issues.

To open the (hidden) technical page, you must use the small “Open Perspective” button (🔧). It can be found on the left end of Collanos Workplace.

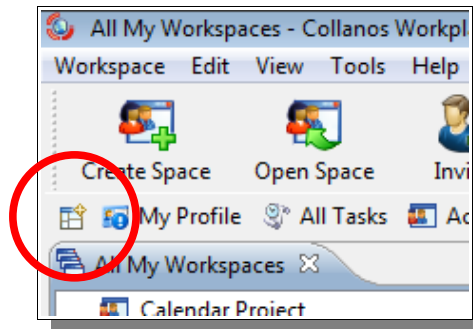


Illustration 3: Open Perspective Button

In the following “Open Perspective” dialog window, select “Technical Info” and click “OK”.

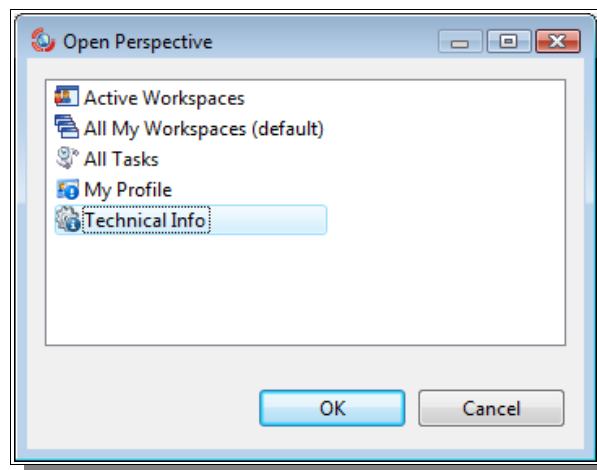


Illustration 4: Open Perspective Dialog

At this point a new perspective will be added to your Collanos Workplace window and opened. You should now have up to five perspectives in your Workplace. Simply click from button to button to switch to another perspective.

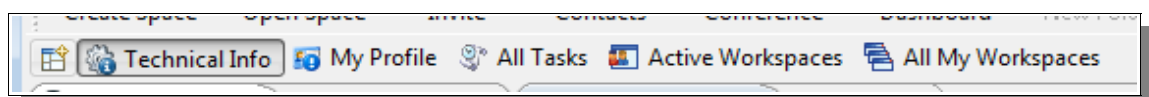


Illustration 5: All five perspectives of Collanos Workplace

The Technical Info perspective contains three parts (or views), represented as “Tabs”.

The tab “**System Service**” lets you check the connectivity to Collanos' Central User Directory (CUD). You can use the button “Ping CUD” on the bottom to see if the central system is available and how fast the CUD will answer to your simple test request (time in milliseconds). This test is actually executing a real Collanos service (i.e. not just a “technical ping of server IP address”). You can execute this test as many times as you want.

The tab “**Peers (Contacts)**” shows all your contacts, including presence information. You can select one (or several) of your contacts from this list to show technical contact details about them. The right side will display these additional details. It is quite technical P2P information, showing connectivity information for the selected contact (to be precise, connectivity information to your contact's computer). For example the “Endpoint Address” section contains information about TCP addresses of the computer. And “Route to Peer” shows which Relay super-peer this remote peer is connected to.

Finally, the “**Super Peers**” tab shows to which “Rendezvous” and “Relay” super-peers your own computer is connected to. The Rendezvous peer is responsible to put you in touch with other peers. It knows when you are online and when offline, and it exchanges your “connectivity information” with other Rendezvous and other Workplace peers. The Relay is responsible to route traffic to other peers, if you and/or others are behind firewalls and network address translators (e.g. network routers).

Please note the “Update Now” button on the bottom. The “Peers (Contacts)” and “Super Peers” views are not refreshing automatically. You can use this button to update to the latest connectivity information.

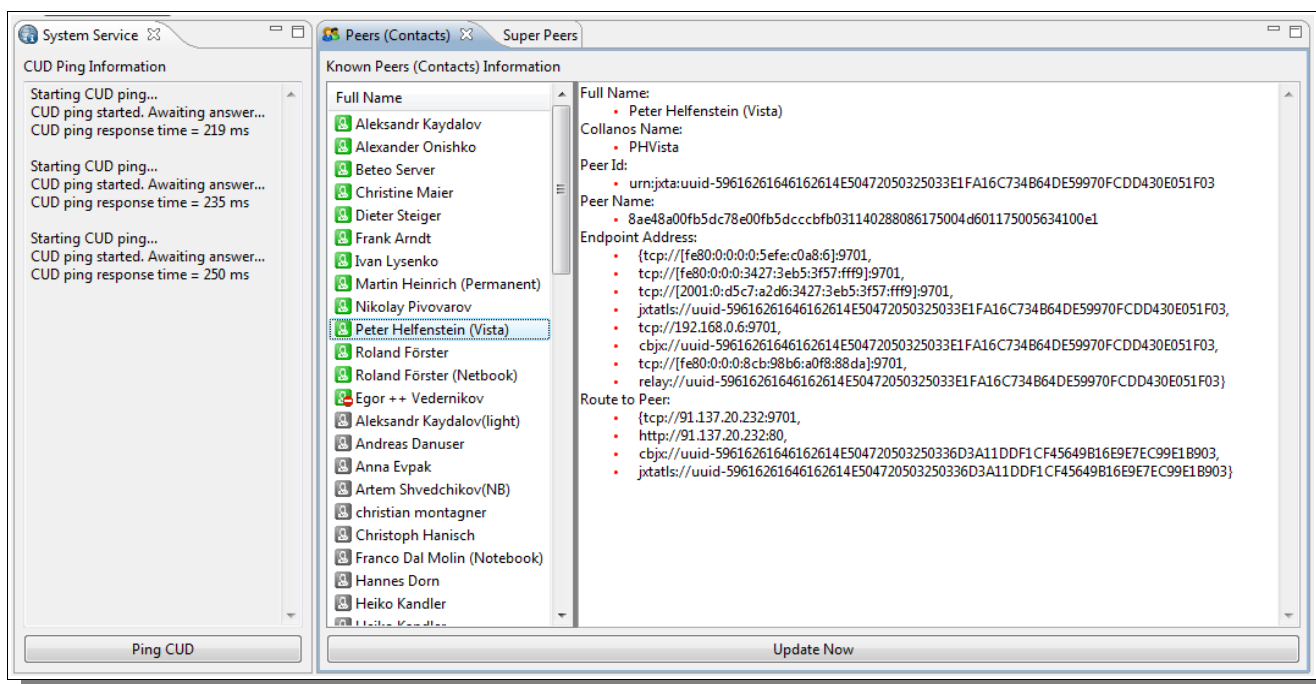


Illustration 6: Technical Info Page

Phone on Mac OS X “Tiger”

The Collanos Phone contained in Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.1 worked only on the most current Mac OS X version (10.5.x “Leopard”). It now works also with the older versions of Macintosh OS X (10.4.x “Tiger”).

Combined Phone Start

In the Preferences settings (on the Collanos Phone page) there is a new option to start Collanos Phone automatically when Collanos Workplace starts. It is switched on by default.

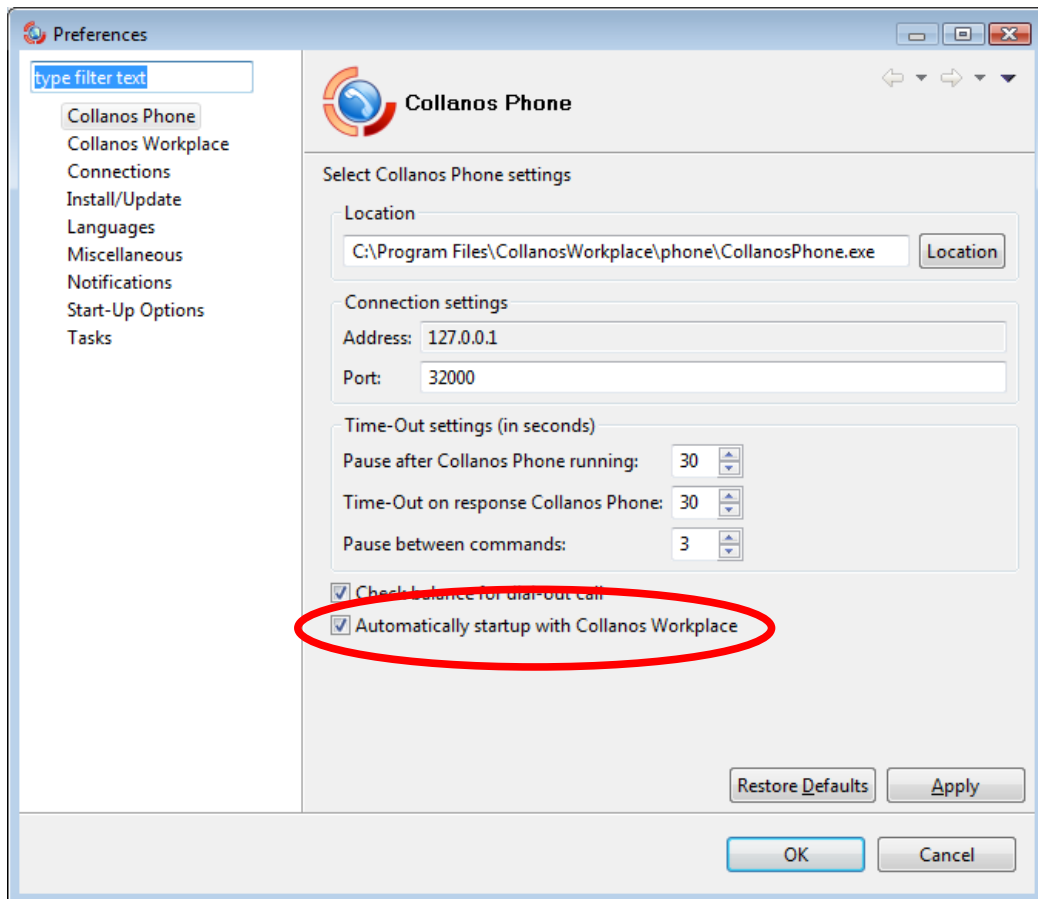


Illustration 7: Preferences for Collanos Phone

Email Verification

All Email fields in your User Profile now use an email address verifier to make sure you entered an existing domain and correct format. This will help to reduce problems related to mistyped email addresses.

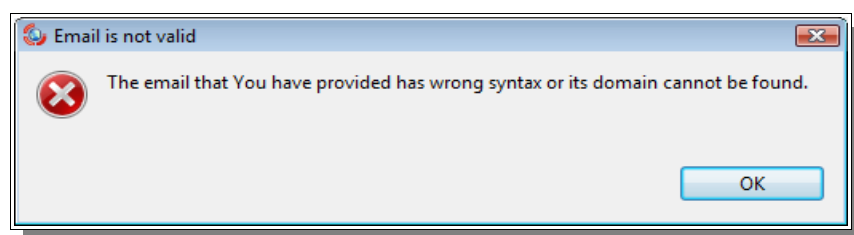


Illustration 8: Warning from the Email Checker

Discussions User Interface

The user interface for workspace-based Discussion objects now contains three buttons: **Location**, **Find**, and **Smile**.

Find and **Smile** work exactly like in the Chat windows. By adding **Find**, which opens/closes a text search feature, and **Smile**, which opens a small palette of “smilies” icons you can add to your messages, we have basically harmonized the user interfaces of Chats and Discussions.

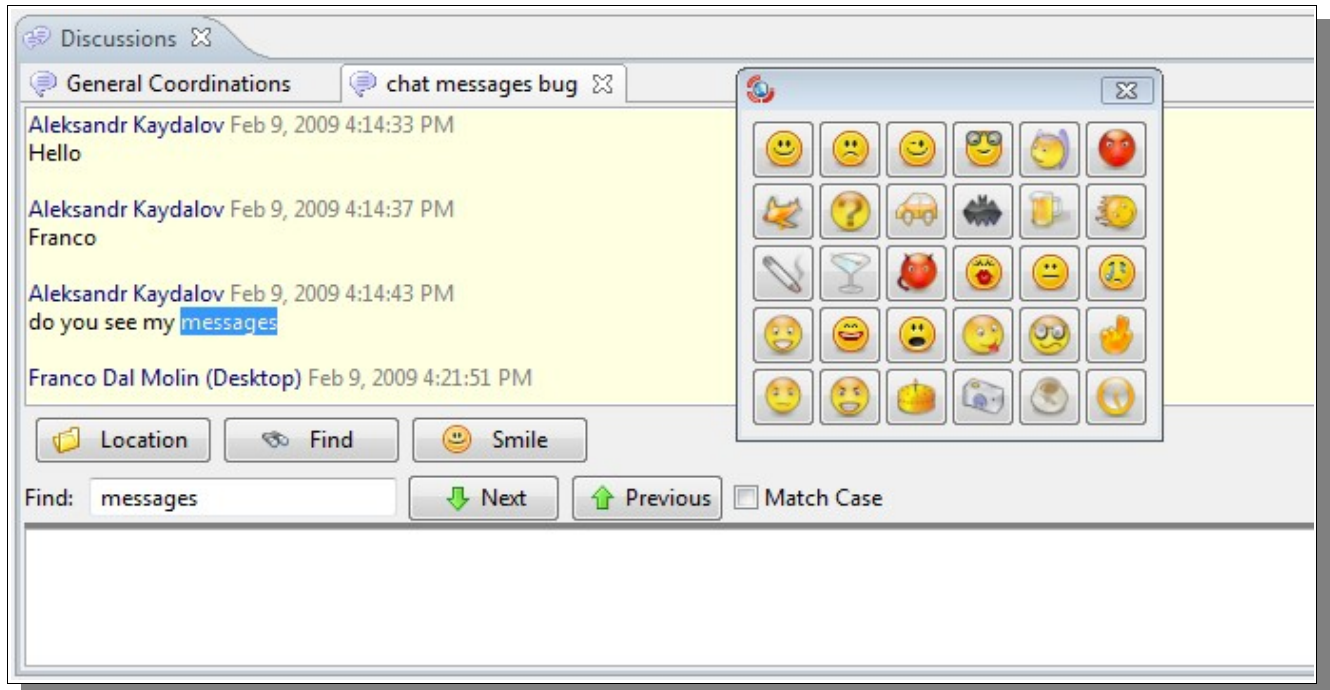


Illustration 9: Discussions GUI with Location, Find, and Smile Buttons

The **Location** button is available (and makes sense) only for Discussion objects. It visually shows you where the active Discussion is actually located as Discussion object in your workspace folder tree. It simply opens the corresponding folder and highlights the Discussion object.

Other Bug Fixes and Improvements

This maintenance release Collanos Workplace 1.4.0.2 includes well over 100 fixed issues and minor improvements. See Appendix A for a complete list.

3 Dial-In Phone Numbers (Premium Service)

A new phone-related premium service is available. As of immediately, users can subscribe to real phone numbers. This number is “mapped” to user's Collanos Name and therefore to his or her Collanos Phone. In other words, users can now be called on this number from anybody from outside of Collanos' network directly on their Collanos Phone.

To subscribe to this new premium service, you need to login on the Web site www.collanos.com (using your existing Collanos Name and Password) and select “Account” on the horizontal top-level menu. On the left side will appear the “Account & Settings” menu where the corresponding command “Dial-In Number” can be found.

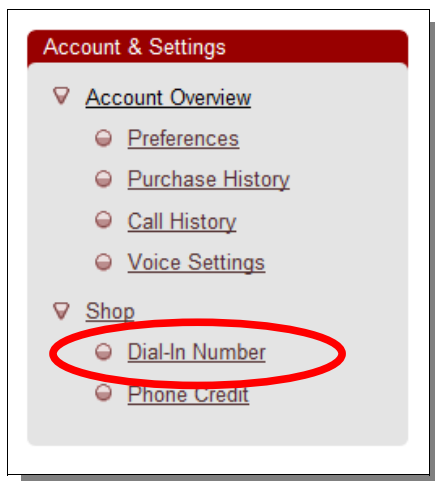



Illustration 11: Account & Settings Menu

Starting in Switzerland – Then Expanding...

The service is initially available only for Switzerland and Swiss numbers. In other words, only residents of Switzerland can currently subscribe to a Swiss Dial-In phone number. That's why the following page contains only Switzerland to select from.

In a couple of months we will add additional countries, like Germany and Austria, and yet another few months later, we will roll out support for more countries around the globe, mainly USA, UK, and others.

After selecting the Country, a special number-selection page is presented. A search filter will help to find preferred numbers. For example, the example on the following screen shows available numbers that contains “000”. Users can select the desired number and press “Go To Billing Details”.

4 Web Application for Text Resource Translations

Our goal is to translate and release Collanos Workplace (as well as other products and services) into as many different languages as possible! Collanos Translators have now access to a new and easy-to-use web application, where they can oversee and perform all their translation work.

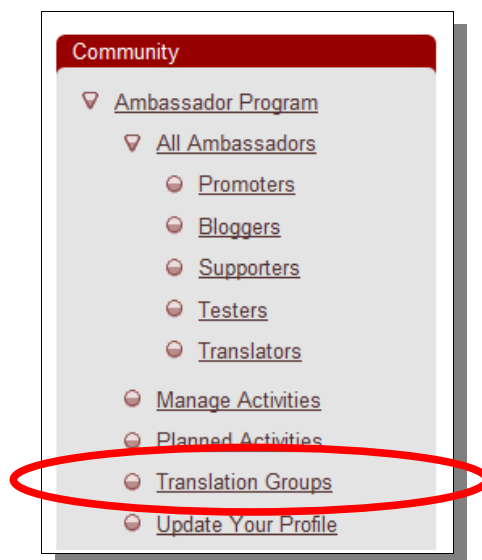


Illustration 15: New Menu Function

If a Translator clicks on this menu point, he or she will get to the “Translation Groups” overview page. On this top level page, Translators can immediately see the completion level of various translation groups. For example, the “User Interfaces” groups has 687 text resources to translate, of which 38 are not yet translated, in other words 94% of this group is translated. To enter the group, the Translator can click on the “Translate” link.

The next page shows a list of all text resources withing this group. The filter on top can be used to reduce the potentially very long list to specific entries, e.g. show only all “Untranslated” text resources, or show only those entries that have their “Need Review” flag set. Translators can click on the “Translate” if they want to translate, modify or comment a particular term.

- More transparent synchronization, show content replication details and new options to influence
- Support of multiple devices with only one unique Collanos Name
- Workspace templates, incl. Web publishing to exchange with others
- Further improvements in task and project management
- Additional contact management and user profile improvements
- Expand historical change logs, to include all system objects and user actions
